## Purpose and Theme of Job

The book of Job surveys different beliefs about how a sovereign God exercises His justice in a fallen world.

Theme: God's sovereign justice

## Content and Message of Job

- 1. Four friends of Job—Eliphaz, Bildad, Zophar, and Elihu—try to help Job see that he is suffering because he has sinned against God and so must repent. Each time Job responds he insists on his innocence and demands answers from God (3–37).
- 2. God reproves Job for questioning Him (38:1–42:6).
- 3. Job repents of his actions and attitude toward God; God doubly restores Job's material blessings (42).
- God's freedom in administering justice in this world should produce in man a submissive faith
