1. Read the notes, pp. 32–35. Did you read them?
2. Read the book of Philemon. Did you read it?
3. Who was Paul? What can you learn from this letter about his current circumstances?
4. Who was Philemon?
5. Who was Onesimus?
6. How did Paul know Philemon and Onesimus?
7. Look at verse 10. What does Paul mean by, “my child Onesimus, whom I have *begotten* in my imprisonment?” What is *not* meant by “begotten”? How do you know?
8. Look at verse 12. What does Paul mean by “sending my very heart”? What does he *not* mean? How do you know?
9. Look at verse 16. Sometimes Paul calls himself a “slave” or “servant” of Christ (Titus 1:1). Is that what “slave” means here in Philemon 16? Explain your answer.
